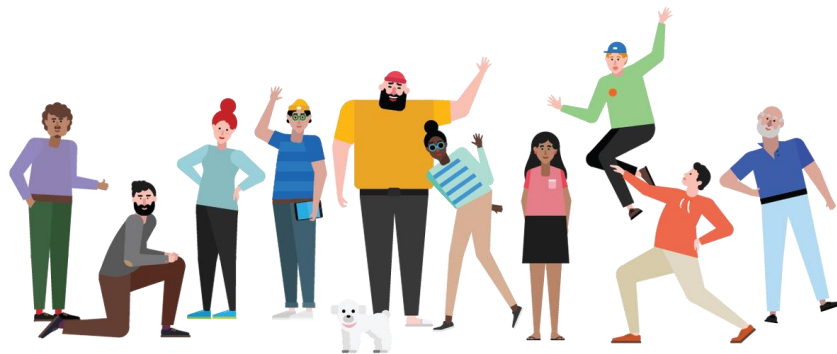


Dear Year 10

More Teaching Sessions Starting Monday 29th June

On Monday much more of your learning will be done alongside your teachers as we ask you to log into **Microsoft Teams** to access lessons like the 'live' lessons you have in the afternoons and the ones you had before some of you started coming into school.



Some of you may be aware that years 7-9 will have a more structured timetable of online lessons next week. You will also have more structure; however, **you will be more responsible for putting that structure into place**. Because many of you have a day per week in school, we cannot schedule your lessons in the same way.

Your option classes will continue to deliver live lessons in the afternoons:

Live Lesson #1	13:30	History x 2	PE/Sport	French	H&SC
Live Lesson #2	14:30	Media and Music	Geography	German	CD

There will be up to two more lessons provided by your options class teachers.

One day a week most of you attend school which leaves four more days for you to arrange to complete the lessons.

The tables below are **examples** of how you might like arrange your week. The deadlines to complete these lessons will be at the end of the week so that you are ready to start again the following week. There may also be some tasks to complete from FROG.

Day 1	English 1	Maths 1	Option S 1
Day 2	Maths 2	English 2	Option T 1
Day 3	Science 1	Option U 1	Option S 2
Day 4	Option U 2	Science 2	Option T 2

If you are invited to a Friday clinic, you may be completing some of your option work in school on a Friday or you may need to fit the above sessions into three days!

Invited to a Fri clinic?	Session 1	Session 2	Session 3	Session 4
Day 1	English 1	Maths 1	Option S 1	Option U 1
Day 2	Maths 2	English 2	Option T 1	Science 1

Day 3	Science 2	Option U 2	Option S 2	Option T 2
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Keep a close eye on your assignments and **make a plan** for your week based on which day you are in school and whether you prefer working in the morning or in the afternoon. Make sure you don't forget to log into the 'live' lessons for your options in the afternoons.

Keep checking your emails and your assignments and get involved in the lessons starting on Monday!
